

FEDERACIÓN SALVADOREÑA DE NATACIÓN INSTRUCTIVO DE CLASIFICACION NACIONAL 14TH FINA WORLD SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS (25M) 11-16 DE DICIEMBRE //HANGZHOU (CHN)

I. Información general:

- El presente instructivo tiene por objeto regular el proceso nacional de selección para nadadores que busquen la asistencia en el Campeonato Mundial FINA del año 2018, los criterios a los que se hace referencia, deben entenderse como necesarios para acceder a la selección, su cumplimiento permite que un deportista sea nominado para la representación de nuestro país en el evento mencionado, los criterios internacionales son las marcas "A" y marcas "B" establecidas por la Federación Internacional de Natación FINA.

II. Programa de eventos :

Libre: 50m, 100m, 200m 400m, 800m (Femenino), 1500m (Masculino), **Dorso:** 50m, 100m, 200m, **Pecho:** 50m, 100m, 200m, **Mariposa:** 50m, 100m, 200m, **Combinado Individual:** 100m 200m, 400m.

III. Requisitos y criterios para conformar la selección:

- A) Establecer marcas de clasificación Internacional, tiempos establecidos por la Federación Internacional de Natación FINA:
- **Marca "A" (Lugar 16 del Pasado Campeonato del Mundo Windsor-CAN 2016):** Para los atletas que establezcan el tiempo mínimo requerido (**tabla adjunta según el Memorándum de FINA**); La Federación Salvadoreña de Natación cubrirá los costos de asistencia en su totalidad (alojamiento, alimentación y transporte). (4 plazas: 2 para hombres y 2 para mujeres).
 - **Marca "B" (Lugar 16 del Pasado Campeonato del Mundo Windsor-CAN 2016 + 3.5%):** de no cubrirse la cuota con Marcas "A", el segundo criterio será la clasificación por medio del tiempo mínimo **B (tabla adjunta según el Memorándum de FINA)**; La Federación Salvadoreña de Natación cubrirá los costos de asistencia en su totalidad (alojamiento, alimentación y transporte). Hasta completar las plazas por género detalladas anteriormente.
- B) Por reglamento FINA solo podrán clasificarse 2 nadadores por prueba y género.
- C) Los seleccionados que se encuentran entrenando en El Salvador, tienen de manera obligatoria participar a los siguientes eventos nacionales: Tomas de tiempo y campeonatos nacionales que se desarrollen durante el periodo de clasificación y concentraciones que sean convocadas por INDES y FSN. (las inasistencias injustificadas podrán ser motivo para que el atleta sea retirado del proceso), si los tiempos se logran en el extranjero el evento deberá de cumplir con los requisitos de la Federación Internacional de Natación FINA.
- D) Los atletas que tienen proyección al mundial tienen como requisito obligatorio presentar ante la FSN su plan de trabajo hasta el Campeonato del Mundo.



- E) Los seleccionados que se encuentran entrenando en el extranjero deberán de enviar a la FSN su plan de trabajo anual y resultados de cada competencia realizada. (el no cumplimiento de estos requisitos podrá ser motivo para que el atleta sea retirado del proceso).
- F) Toda comunicación relacionada a procesos de selección con organismos nacionales o internacionales deberán de realizarse por medio de Federación Salvadoreña de Natación.
- G) De existir cantidad de nadadores que superen las plazas asignadas se utilizara el criterio de la mejor marca técnica por medio de los puntos FINA.
- H) De lo no establecido en el presente manual de clasificación, la Federación Salvadoreña de Natación, mediante análisis técnico resolverá.

IV. Atletas Seleccionados:

- Los atletas y sus representantes legales tendrán que firmar un formulario de compromiso sobre su participación en el campeonato del mundo FINA 2018 y las actividades de preparación e información que convoque la Federación Salvadoreña de Natación.
- Cualquier atleta que sea sancionado por incumplimiento de normas de conducta que establecen los reglamentos de selecciones, podrá ser retirado del proceso.

- Los atletas seleccionados tienen como requisito obligatorio entregar a la FSN:
 - A.** Constancias médicas que sean solicitadas durante el periodo de clasificación o preparación hacia el campeonato del mundo 2018.
 - B.** Informe mensual de sus actividades de entrenamiento.

- Cualquier nadador que se viese afectado por una enfermedad, lesión y todo aquel estado de salud que afecte con su buen rendimiento en cualquier momento entre el periodo de clasificación o de preparación previo al Campeonato del Mundo 2018 deberá notificarlo a la FSN de manera inmediata, será requerido presentar los exámenes médicos que sean necesarios y reporte de buena salud.

Dear Sirs,

As per the published Memorandum sent on 11TH December 2017 for “Swimming Qualification Events and Times” for the 25m Championships (see below), time standards have been introduced for the first time for Hangzhou 2018.

The FINA TSC has decided to apply the long course Gwangju 2019 time standards for Hangzhou in addition to the previously published 25m standard times. This allows federations to enter swimmers who meet the approved short course OR long course standards.

A summary of the entries rules is listed below:

- FINA A/B/U qualification rules are still in force as per the FINA Handbook
 - National Federations will be able to submit times for athletes from qualifying competitions in 25m distance or 50m distance.
- Qualifying competitions must have been previously approved by FINA and fall within the qualification period of:
 - 01 August 2017 – 22 November 2018 for **25m Competitions (for Hangzhou 2018)**
 - 01 March 2018 – 22 November 2018 for **50m Competitions (for Gwangju 2019)**
- All entry times **MUST** be included in the FINA World Swimming Rankings in order to be validated
- When submitting sport entries, it must be stated if the entry time is from an approved 25m or 50m competition
- 25m entry times will be checked against qualifications standards for FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) Hangzhou 2018
- 50m entry times will be checked against qualifications standards for FINA World Championships Gwangju 2019
- There is no restriction on an athlete entering with times from both 25m and 50m competitions according to the FINA A/B/U rules
- All entry times will be seeded as per FINA rules regardless of whether the entry time was achieved in a 25m or 50m pool
- 50m entry times will not be converted

Below are the 50m Standard times that will be applied for the 14th FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) 2018 – Hangzhou (CHN).

Dear Sirs,

Following our correspondence of 7th August 2017, please refer to the updated qualifying A and B times to be implemented for the Swimming competitions at the **14th FINA World Swimming Championships (25m)** to be held in Hangzhou (CHN) from 11th to 16th December 2018.

1. STANDARD TIMES:

A Standard = 16th place from Windsor (CAN) 2016

B Standard = + 3.5%

2. QUALIFICATION PERIOD: 1st AUGUST 2017 – 22nd NOVEMBER 2018:

If a National Federations enters only one (1) swimmer per event all swimmers entered must meet the qualifying B standard time. If two (2) swimmers are entered in the same event, both of them must meet the qualifying A standard time.

Federations may enter swimmers regardless of standard time as follows:

having no swimmer qualified: two (2) men and two (2) women; *

having one (1) or two (2) swimmers qualified, additional swimmers up to a maximum of four (4) swimmers (two (2) men and two (2) women);

having three (3) swimmers qualified one (1) additional swimmer provided that both gender are represented.

* *Note: Please refer to FINA Rule BL 9.3.6 and BL 9.3.6.2*

BL 9.3.6 The minimum age for swimmers competing in the Olympic Games, FINA World Championships and FINA World Swimming Championships (25m) shall be the same as the minimum age for the FINA World Junior Swimming Championships: Women, 14 years of age, and Men, 15 years of age, on 31st December in the year of competition, except younger athletes may participate in these competitions if they have achieved at least the "B" Standard Entry Time in the respective event.

BL 9.3.6.2 At the World Championships, National Federations may enter swimmers who have not achieved either Standard Entry Time as follows:

a) With no swimmers who have achieved the "A" or "B" Standard Entry Time: National Federations may enter up to four (4) swimmers, two (2) men and two (2) women. b) With one (1) or two (2) swimmers who has achieved the "A" or "B" Standard Entry Time: National Federations may enter up to a maximum of four (4) swimmers (two (2) men and two (2) women), and with three (3) swimmers who have achieved the "A" or "B" Standard Entry Time, one (1) additional swimmer provided that both genders are represented. c) The swimmers who have not achieved either Standard Entry Time will only be permitted to enter up to two (2) individual events each. d) An individual entry for a swimmer without an "A" or "B" Standard Entry Time must be in an event where no other swimmer from the National Federation has been entered.

Swimmers entered without qualifying time must have participated in the National Championships of the Federation. These swimmers will be allowed to enter in two (2) different events each, but they cannot swim in the same event, p.a. 50 m Freestyle.

Gender Relays:

4x50 m Freestyle, 4x100m Freestyle, 4x200m Freestyle, 4x50 m Medley, 4x100m Medley – Men & Women – 1 Relay per Federation

Mixed Relays: 4x50 m Freestyle, 4x50m Medley – 1 Relay per Federation.

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3. QUALIFYING EVENTS – SEE BL 12:

- # Continental Championships 2017 and 2018
- # International Competitions,
- # National Competitions

FINA will only accept entry times which have been achieved at competitions officially approved by FINA.

4. APPLICATION FOR QUALIFYING EVENTS:

If your Federation will organise an International Competition or a National Qualifying Meet where the swimmers could achieve the FINA “A” and “B” Qualifying Standard Times, please fill out the attached “Application Form” and return it to the FINA Office in Lausanne (SUI) as soon as possible taking into account the following:

Competitions held between 1st August 2017 and 31st December 2017 should be approved before they take place. Competitions held in 2018 should be approved by FINA not later than 31st December 2017.

NO APPLICATION FOR A NATIONAL AND/OR INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER 31st DECEMBER 2017.

We would like to draw your attention to the following:

- it is very important to indicate on the “Application Form” the INFORMATION ON THE TIMING SYSTEM to be used at the competitions to be organised by the National Federations where the swimmers could achieve the FINA “A” and “B” Qualifying Standard Times.

- FINA will only recognise the swimming competitions where Referees and Starters included on the FINA Swimming Officials Lists N° 18 and N° 19.

- In order for FINA to endorse the Swimming Qualifying Time Standards achieved at approved competitions, the National Federation / Organiser **must** send to the FINA Office in Lausanne (SUI) the official results in an electronic file (ONLY Lenex or Hy-Tek cl2/sdif will be accepted) IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE CONCLUSION OF THE COMPETITION. No .pdf or .excel files will be accepted.
